1. Attenuated -- slender, thin
2. Comely – attractive
3. Corpulent -- fat, fleshly
4. Dandy -- a man whose style of dress is ostentatiously elegant or fashionable
5. Dapper -- neat, trim, smart in dress or appearance
6. Emaciated -- abnormally thin or wasted
7. Frowzy -- dirty, untidy, neglected in appearance
8. Gaunt -- slim, especially from lack of nourishment
9. Homely -- plain or unattractive in appearance
10. Lanky -- awkwardly or ungracefully lean or long
11. Obese -- very overweight
12. Pallid -- pale, especially from illness or shock
13. Pulchritudinous – beautiful
14. Rangy -- tall and thin
15. Rotund -- round, plump
16. Sartorial -- pertaining to clothing or to tailors
17. Slattern -- an untidy and slovenly woman
18. Slovenly -- untidy, dirty
19. Soignée -- meticulously dressed, well-groomed
20. Stout -- fat, corpulent
21. Svelte -- slender, willowy, elegant, graceful
22. Swarthy -- dark-complexioned
23. Unkempt -- untidy, having a neglected appearance
24. Wan -- unhealthily pale, of a grayish, sickly color
